## KID'S LESSON PROGRAMS



#### MOUNTAIN MITE LESSONS - MUST PURCHASE IN ADVANCE

Grand Geneva Resort's Mountain Mites program utilizes a structured lesson plan in which professionally trained instructors teach students between the ages of 7 and 13 the basics of skiing or snowboarding and safety. Students are required to wear helmets at all lessons.

This program is formulated for fun and will be available on select Saturdays and Sundays hroughout the year. Class begins promptly and runs from 9:30 am-12 pm. Helmet use is mandatory.

Lessons must be purchased online, at least 48 hours in advance. No lessons will be available for purchase on the day of skiing. Lift ticket and rentals are not included and must be purchased separately.
